- Working toward a degree in one of the following occupational areas of agriculture and/or agribusiness:

 - Ag Business
 - Agricultural Research
 - Conservational and Natural Resources
 - Economics
 - Education
 - Environmental Systems
 - Forestry/Natural Resources
 - Horticulture

 - Nursing

NOTE: The PCFB Scholarship program does not include the following fields: Pre-Medicine (including medical doctor, medical research, etc.), Physical/Occupational Therapy, General Pharmacy, Dentistry, Radiology, Accounting, and Athletic Training.

Students must maintain a minimum 2.5 grade point average throughout their high school or college career and be pursuing a degree in agriculture, nursing or education to continue to qualify for the four-year renewable scholarship. Students must maintain at least a 12-unit workload and/or be considered a full-time student paying full-time tuition.

Graduate students are not eligible for this scholarship.
