PLACER AG DAY PLANNED FOR MARCH 22ND AT FAIRGROUNDS

The Placer County Farm Bureau, Echo Valley Ranch, the Placer Resource Conservation District, and the Gold Country Fair Heritage Foundation are hosting an "Ag Day" educational event at the Gold Country Fairgrounds in Auburn on March 22, 2019.

The event is being held in conjunction with National Ag Week, a nationwide effort to teach students about their food, fiber, and environment. This is the sixth year Ag Day is being held in Placer County. On March 22nd, third through fifth grade students from around the County are invited to the Gold Country Fairgrounds to rotate through stations on various agricultural and natural resources topics, such as mandarins, bees, wildlife, forestry, water, and livestock.

Each student will also receive a PlacerGROWN bag with educational materials and take-home agricultural products such as honey and a tree seedling. Teachers will receive curriculum and classroom activities. Many local and regional volunteers are contributing by presenting at the stations, donating the materials and agricultural products, and otherwise supporting the event.

Media, elected officials, and guests are welcome. Please locate the "Guest Check-In" table upon arrival to sign in and receive a name badge. Any media photos of the students will need to be approved before printing; we will have more instructions on this at the event.
